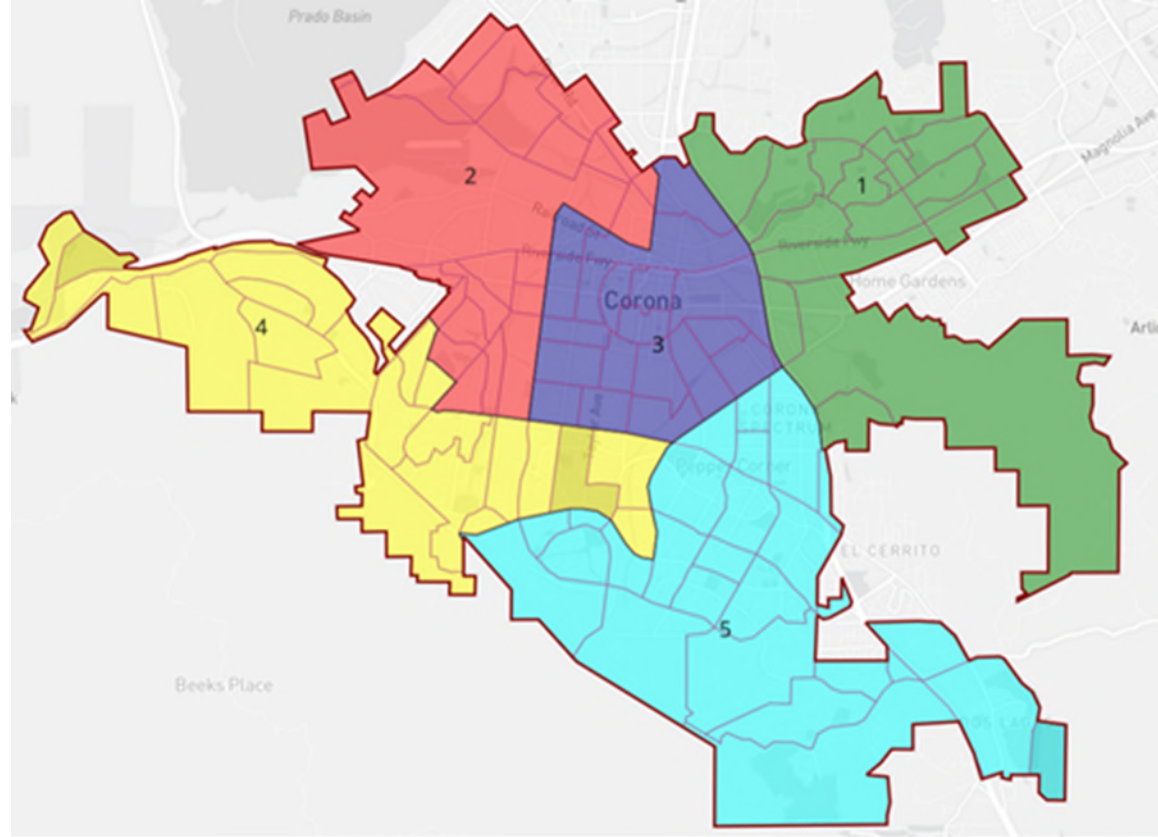

Redistricting Process

STEP	DATE	DESCRIPTION
✓ Public Hearing #1	January 5, 2022	Present an overview of the redistricting process, hearing from community on communities of interest
✓ Release draft maps	February 2, 2022	Draft maps posted to project website
✓ Public Hearing #2	February 5, 2022	Review Draft maps Take public input Consider Communities of Interest
✓ Initial deadline for draft maps	February 16, 2022	Deadline for the public to submit draft maps for inclusion in the next hearing packet and presentation
<input type="checkbox"/> Public Hearing #3	March 16, 2022	Public Hearing to discuss and revise, if desired, the draft map(s)
<input type="checkbox"/> Public Hearing No. 4 - Map adoption	April 17, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Map adopted via ordinance or resolution• Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption
